Intent

- To provide a broad and balanced PE curriculum that meets the needs of every child.
- To inspire children to become lifelong, active individuals.
- To develop the understanding of a range of sporting activities.
- To develop skills for working both individually and as part of a team.
- To support children in their early development of becoming healthy individuals and the understanding of continuing a healthy lifestyle.

Implementation
